

# Euvic is compatible with GDPR

## What is this document for?

On 25th May, 2018, the European Parliament and Council Regulation number 2016/679 signed on 27th April 2016 comes into force. The regulation is on data protection and privacy for all individuals with regards to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data. GDPR introduces a number of changes, which is why we have created this document - it contains a set of information confirming the Euvic's compatibility with GDPR.

## How did Euvic prepare for the entry of GDPR?

We paid a lot of attention to adapt to the upcoming changes. As an administrator and entity that is processing personal data on behalf of other administrators (members of the Euvic Group), we have implemented and we follow the rules set out in GDPR regulations and in the 10th May, 2018 Act on the protection of personal data.

Particularly:

- We compiled a register of personal data processing processes,
- We clearly defined the objectives and legal basis regarding the processes of the data processing,
- We performed a threat analysis, estimated the risks, and assessed the consequences of processing your personal data,
- Basing on analyzes, as a standard binding at Euvic, we implemented appropriate and adequate protection of processing processes,
- We also designated the Data Protection Supervisor,
- The Data Protection Supervisor adequately trained and authorized our personnel to process personal data.

## GDPR fundamentals

The processing of personal data should be designed to serve man. The right to the protection of personal data is not an absolute right; it should be seen in the context of its social function and it should be balanced in accordance with other fundamental rights and the principle of proportionality. This Regulation respects the fundamental rights, freedoms and principles recognized in the Charter of Fundamental Rights - enshrined in the Treaties - in particular the right to respect the private and family life, home and communication, protection of personal data, freedom of thought, conscience and religion, freedom of speech and information, the freedom to conduct a business, the right to an effective remedy and access to an impartial court, and the right to cultural, religious and linguistic diversity.

## What is personal data?

Personal data is information about an identified or identifiable natural person (the "data subject"). An identifiable natural person is a person who can be directly or indirectly identified, in particular on the basis of an identifier such as name, identification number, location data, Internet identifier or one or more specific factors determining physical, physiological, genetic, psychological, economic, cultural or social identity of a natural person.

## What are the rights of people in the light of the GDPR?

GDPR guarantees individuals a number of rights that we declare to comply with. Here are the most important rights:

- Right to access to the data,
- Right to rectify the data,
- Right to be forgotten,
- Right to limitation of data processing,
- Right to opposition and not to make decisions based on automated processing.
